1. Scholarship program: 1 year Korean language course + 2 years of Master's or 3 years of Doctoral

2. Amount of scholarship (approx. US\$1=1,100KRW)

- 100% tuition fee (Korean language course and degree program) waive, round trip air fare
- Living expenses (monthly allowance): 900,000KRW (approx. US\$818.00) per month
- Research allowance, settlement allowance, dissertation printing costs, medical insurance etc.
