Only accepted papers are published in the conference proceedings and considered for oral presentation. Qualified papers could be published in the **Springer Book** or in the **Inzynieria Mineralna Journal**. All the papers in the Springer book or in the Inzynieria Mineralna Journal will be indexed in Scopus database. Posters are the other alternative of oral presentations.

Authors are kindly reminded to follow the requirements for the conference manuscripts:

- Being original work that has never been submitted for publication elsewhere;
- Being between 8,000 to 10,000 words in length and prepared on A4 size papers follow strictly the proceedings template.
